

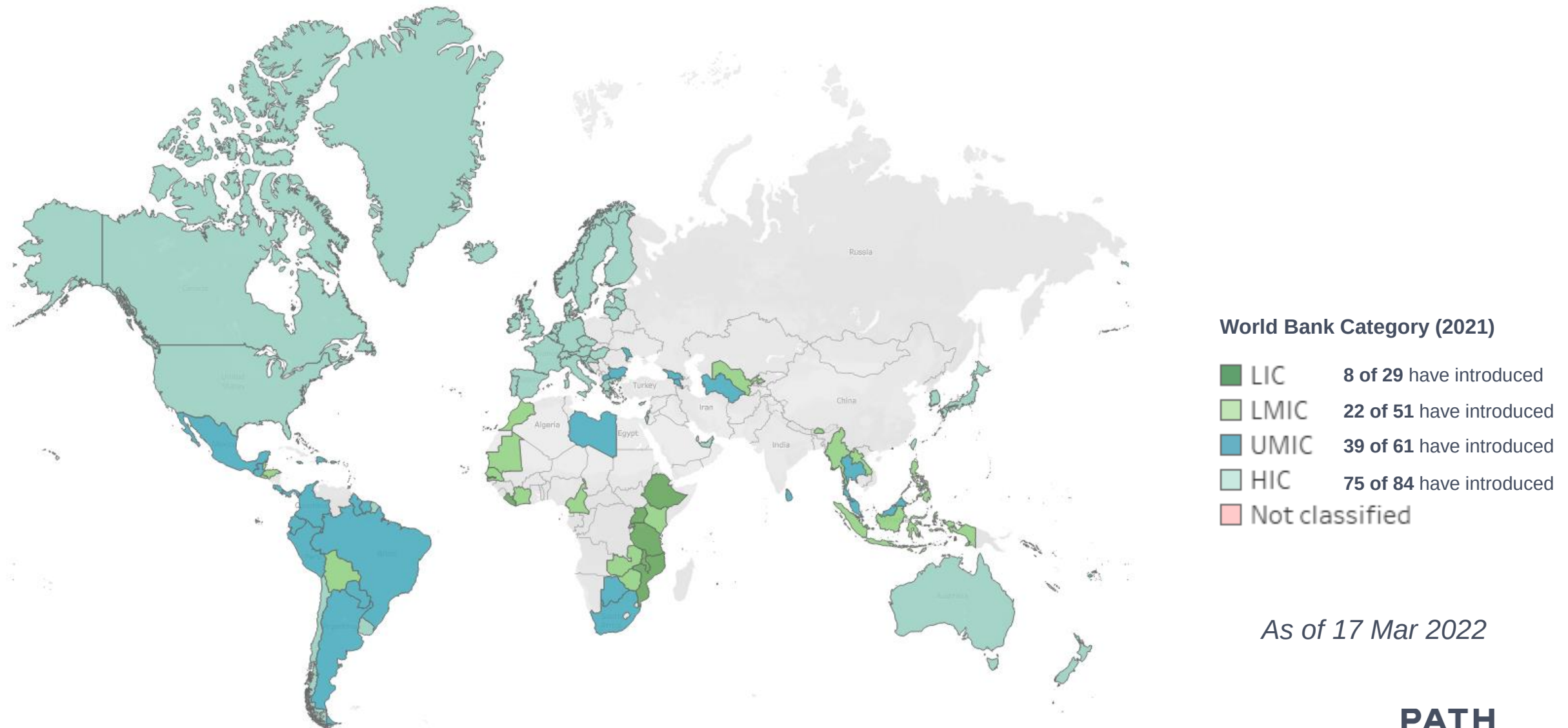

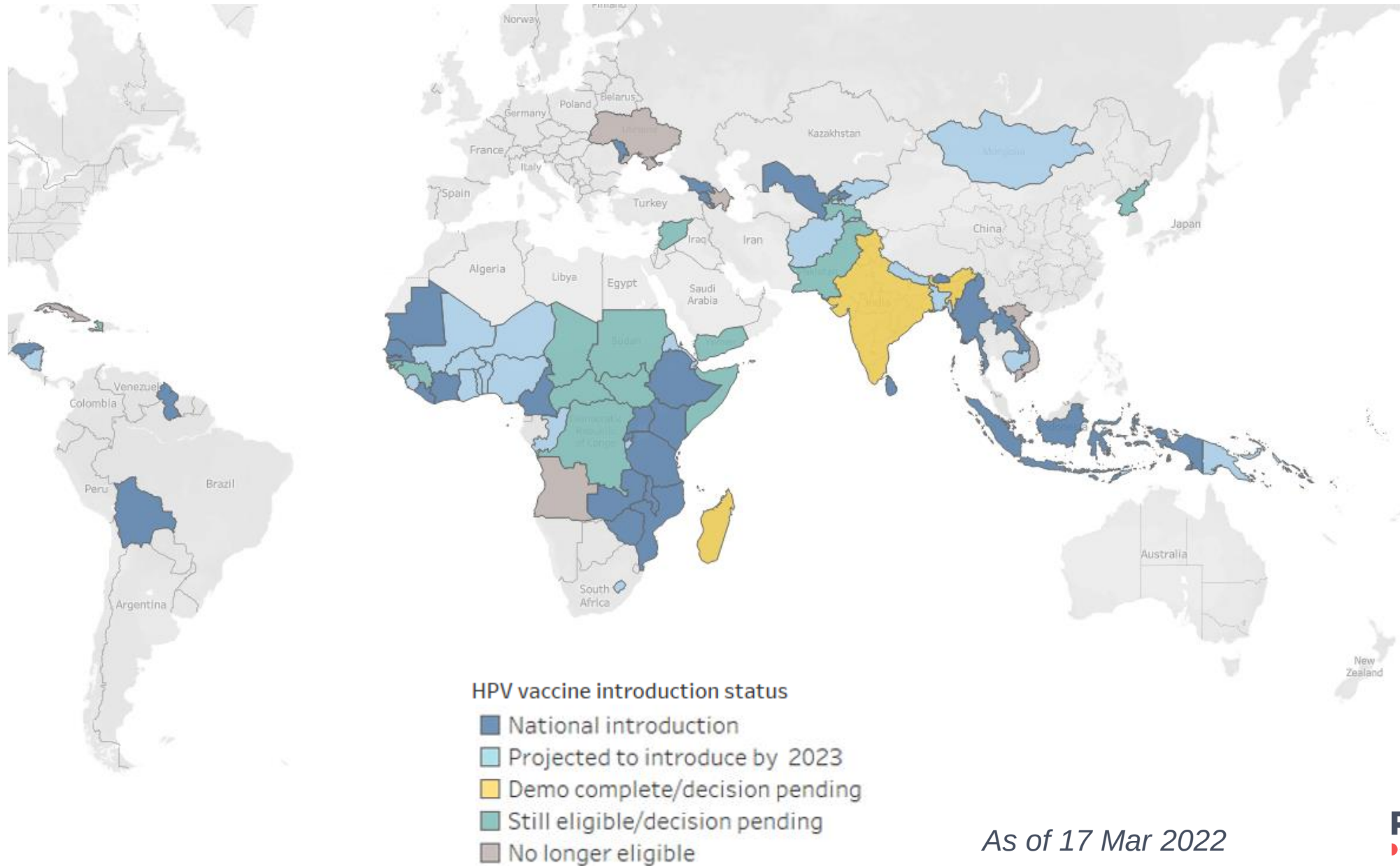

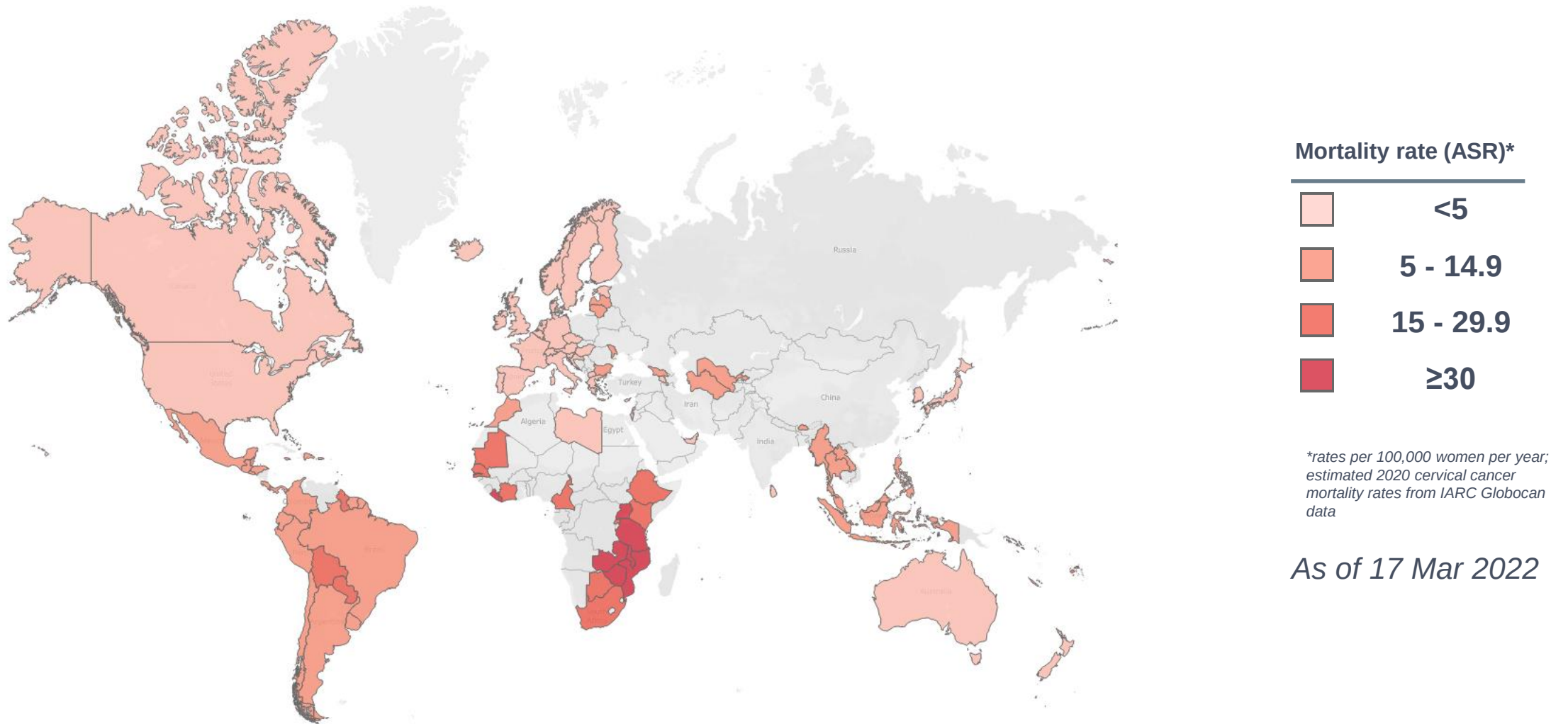
Global HPV Vaccine Introductions by World Bank Category



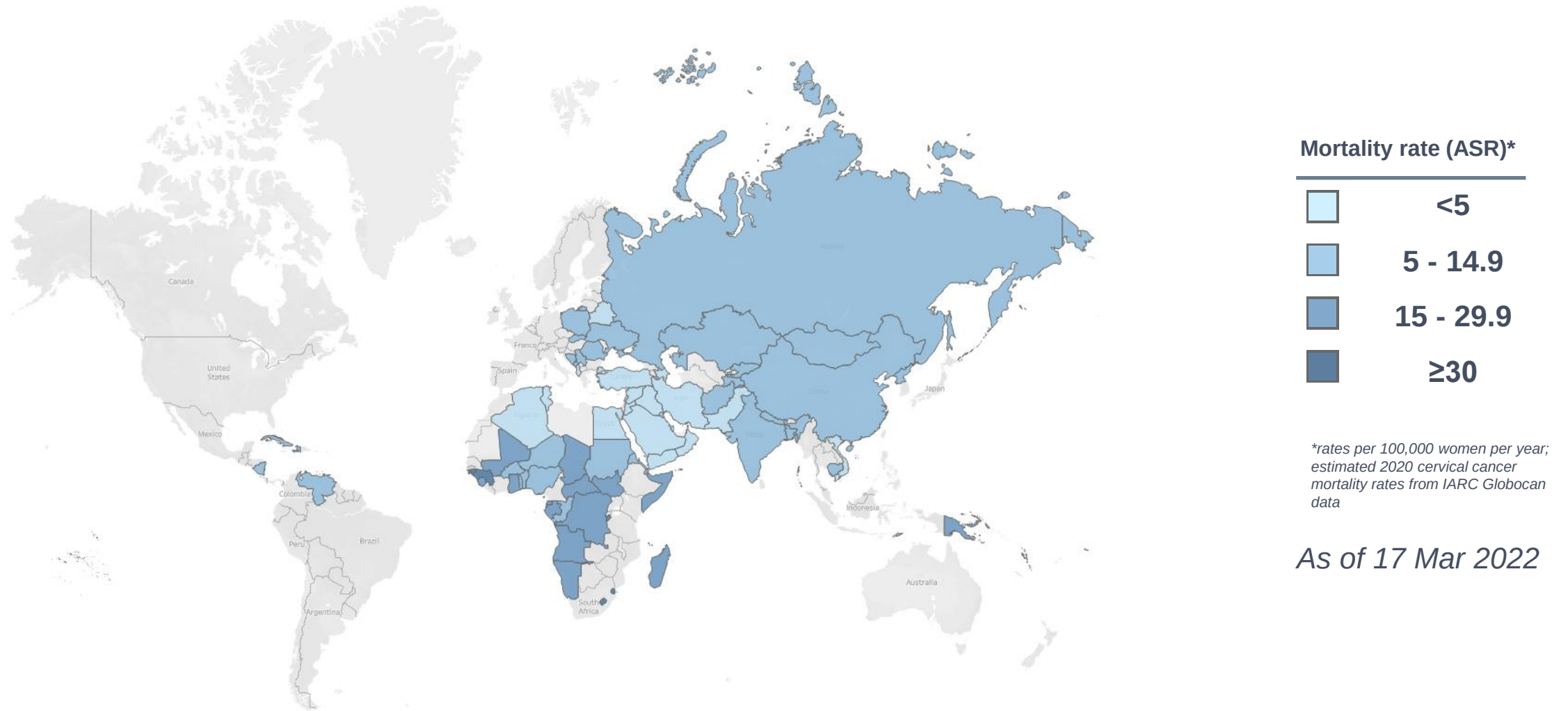
HPV Vaccine Introduction Status in Gavi Countries Eligible for HPV Support
